- l, Professor Kanhaiya Lal Shrivastava, Vice-Chancellor, Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur in exercise of powers vested in me under Section 12(5) of the Act of Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur, hereby approve the scheme of examination and guidelines for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes of Faculty of Arts/Science/Commerce based on semester (NEP = 2020), as under:
  - To conduct the Mid-term test after completion of Three Units instead of Five Units for the newly admitted students (in the Academic Session 2024-2025) and the previously admitted students in third Semester (Academic Session 2023-2024 & onwards)
  - 2 To adopt the Examination Scheme for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes of Faculty of Arts/Science Commerce of NEP - 2020, for the students who were admitted in the University in Academic Session 2023-2024 (presently in III Semester onwards), as follows:

3. The duration of Mid Term Test will be 2 hours for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses. The scheme for Mid Term Test will be as under:-

Section A 10 questions of 2 marks each all compulsory.

Minimum 3 and maximum 4 questions from each unit)

10x2 Marks = 20 Marks

Section B – 2 questions from each unit, total 6 questions, attempt one from each unit, each question 10 marks

3x10 Marks = 30 Marks

Total = 50 Marks

Schedule for Mid Term Test will be notified by the Academic Section in consultation with all the Deans & Directors every year.

4. The private candidates of 1 Year (II Semester) and II Year (IV Semester) of degree courses and M.A. (II Semester) (NEP – 2020 Courses) can be admitted as regular candidate in the next class provided that:

For admission to the II year (III Semester) as a regular candidate, the candidate must have secured 50% marks in the I year ((average of I & II Semesters).

For admission to III year (V Semester) as a regular candidate, the candidate must have secured 50% marks in the aggregate in I and II year (I to IV Semester).

For admission to Postgraduate final class (III Semester) as a regular candidate, candidate must have secured 55% marks at the postgraduate (Previous) examination (average of I & II Semesters).

The admission will be made on the following conditions:

- i. Admission of these candidates will be done only in the last partially filled section. No specialisation will be started at the post-graduate final level as a result of admission of these candidates.
- ii. The admission of these candidates will be strictly on the basis of merit and availability of seapers.
